Put the Beach To Bed Day:	The fall workday was held on Saturday, October 16 th , starting at 9:00 a.m. Todd took down the dock with help from Joel. Loam was brought in and spread in the depression by the outhouse and on Roger's Island where the microburst had ripped up some trees. Grass seed was planted in these areas as well. Phragmites for the cabana were cut and bundled and the picnic tables were put in beach house.
Agreement With Zabel's:	Joel e-mailed Bill Zabel to discuss the pasture fence line currently on his property. As expected, Bill indicated that he would like the fence line as a boundary-line marker as opposed to on his land. He has agreed to go 50/50 with BBC on the cost of the fence as a boundary-line marker. There is 253 feet of fence line. Annual Shareholder's Meeting:	The annual shareholder's meeting was held on November 27 th , 2010 at the home of Joel E. Helander and was attended by many. More audio recording of Eliot H. Benton was played and enjoyed by all. As in the past the lasagna dinner and the many appetizers and desserts were delicious. Thanks to all who contributed and attended.
Fireplace Update:	During a recent fall fire in the new fireplace, a section of the concrete floor burst, leaving a shallow concave. After research, it was determined that in addition to the firebrick that was used to line the walls, it would be prudent to also have firebrick lining the floor. Ellen purchased firebrick and it now spans the entire floor. It does not need to be mortared in. Ellen will contact Mike Schaefer to make sure he used fireproof mortar on the rest of the fireplace. The new firebrick on the base does not occlude the vent. Care will have to be taken to make sure the ash build-up does not eventually occlude the vents.

2011 Budget: The treasurer presented the board with a few budget worksheets with which to discuss the budget for the coming year. She was able to project the remaining expenses for 2010 and it was noted that the 2010 budget was used as appropriated in all areas.
